1. Approval for divestment of shares of Inox Wind Limited, a material subsidiary

To consider and if thought fit, to pass the following resolution as a **Special Resolution**:

"RESOLVED THAT pursuant to Regulation 24(5) of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, ("Listing Regulations"), the applicable provisions, if any, of the Companies Act, 2013, read with Rules made thereunder, Memorandum and Articles of Association of the Company and subject to any other approvals, permissions and sanctions as may be required, the consent of the Members of the Company be and is hereby accorded to the Board of Directors of the Company (which term shall deem to include IWEL Committee of the Board of Directors for Operations or any officer/ executive/ representative and/ or any other person so authorized by the Board or the Committee) to divest by way of sale, transfer, pledge, assign or dispose of or otherwise transfer to one or more potential investors, in one or more tranches, the equity shares of Inox Wind Limited (IWL), a material subsidiary of the Company to less than or equal to 50% (fifty percent) of the total equity share capital of IWL or cease to exercise the control over the subsidiary."

"**RESOLVED FURTHER THAT** the Board of Directors of the Company (which term shall deem to include IWEL Committee of the Board of Directors for Operations or any officer/ executive/ representative and/ or any other person so authorized by the Board or the Committee), be and is hereby authorized on behalf of the Company to negotiate/ finalize the term(s) and condition(s) of such divestment including price, market or off-market divestment and to sign necessary documents in this behalf including the application(s) to be filed for obtaining requisite approvals, if any, from the relevant authorities and to do all such acts, deeds, matters and things as it may, in its absolute discretion, deem necessary and to settle any questions, difficulties or doubts that may arise in this regard without requiring the Board to secure any further consent or approval of the Members of the Company."

The Ministry of Corporate Affairs ('MCA') has vide its General Circulars No. 14/2020 dated 8th April, 2020, No. 17/2020 dated 13th April, 2020 and No. 9/2023 dated 25th September, 2023 (collectively referred to as 'MCA Circulars') and the Securities and Exchange Board of India ('SEBI') vide its Circular No. SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD1/CIR/P/2020/79 dated 12th May, 2020, No. SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD2/CIR/P/2021/11 dated 15th January, 2021 and No. SEBI/HO/CFD/P0D-2/P/CIR/2023/4 dated 5th January, 2023 (collectively referred to as 'SEBI Circulars') permitted the holding of the Extra-Ordinary General Meeting ('EGM'/'the Meeting') through VC/ OAVM, without the physical presence of the Members at a common venue.
- 2. In compliance with the applicable provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 (including any statutory modification(s) or re-enactment(s) thereof, for the time being in force) read with Rule 20 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 (the "Rules"), as amended from time to time, read with the MCA Circulars, SEBI Circulars and pursuant to Regulation 44 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations & Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 ("Listing Regulations"), the 5th Extra-ordinary General Meeting (the "EGM" or the "Meeting") of the Members of Inox Wind Energy Limited (the "Company") is scheduled to be held on Wednesday, 25th October, 2023 at 11:30 A.M.(IST) through VC/ OAVM. Accordingly, the Members can attend and participate in the ensuing EGM through VC/ OAVM. They can also vote on the item(s) to be transacted at the Meeting as mentioned in this Notice through electronic voting process ("e-Voting") via remote e-Voting or e-Voting during the EGM by following the procedure as detailed below in Note Nos. 9 to 12.
- 3. The attendance of the Members participating in the EGM through VC/ OAVM Facility shall be counted for the purpose of reckoning the quorum under Section 103 of the Companies Act, 2013.
- 4. SINCE THIS EGM IS BEING HELD PURSUANT TO THE MCA CIRCULARS MENTIONED ABOVE THROUGH VC/ OAVM, THE REQUIREMENT OF PHYSICAL ATTENDANCE OF MEMBERS HAS BEEN DISPENSED WITH. ACCORDINGLY, IN TERMS OF THE MCA CIRCULARS AND THE SEBI CIRCULARS, THE FACILITY OF APPOINTMENT OF PROXIES BY MEMBERS TO ATTEND AND VOTE AT THE EGM IS NOT AVAILABLE FOR THIS EGM AND HENCE, THE PROXY FORM, ATTENDANCE SLIP AND ROUTE MAP OF EGM ARE NOT ANNEXED TO THIS NOTICE.

However, in pursuance of Sections 112 and 113 of the Companies Act, 2013, the representatives of the Members may be appointed for the purpose of voting through remote e-Voting or for participation and voting during the meeting held through VC/ OAVM and in this regard should send the necessary documents to the Company.

- 5. Institutional investors who are Members of the Company are encouraged to attend and vote in the EGM being held through VC/ OAVM.
- 6. The Explanatory Statement pursuant to Section 102(1) of the Companies Act, 2013 with respect to the Special Business as mentioned in the Notice is annexed hereto.
- 7. We request the Members to register/ update their e-mail address with their Depository Participant, in case they have not already registered/ updated the same. Members who are holding shares in physical form are requested to get their e-mail address registered with the Registrar and Share Transfer Agents of the Company.

- iii. Members who have voted through Remote e-Voting will be eligible to attend the EGM. However, they will not be eligible to again vote at the EGM.

iv. The details of the person who may be contacted for any grievances connected with the facility for e-Voting on the day of the EGM shall be the same person mentioned for Remote e-voting.

12. Instructions for Members for attending the EGM through VC/OAVM

- i. Member will be provided with a facility to attend the EGM through VC/OAVM through the NSDL e-Voting system. Members may access by following the steps mentioned above for "Access to NSDL e-Voting system". After successful login, you can see link of "VC/OAVM" placed under "Join Meeting" menu against Company name. You are requested to click on VC/OAVM link placed under Join Meeting menu. The link for VC/OAVM will be available in Shareholder/Member login where the EVEN of Company i.e. 126896 will be displayed. Please note that the members who do not have the User ID and Password for e-Voting or have forgotten the User ID and Password may retrieve the same by following the remote e-Voting instructions mentioned in the notice to avoid last minute rush.
- ii. Members are encouraged to join the Meeting through Laptops for better experience.
- iii. Members are requested use good speed Internet in order to avoid any disturbance during the meeting.
- iv. Please note that Participants Connecting from Mobile Devices or Tablets or through Laptop connecting via Mobile Hotspot may experience Audio/Video loss due to fluctuation in their respective network. It is therefore recommended to use Stable Wi-Fi or LAN Connection to mitigate any kind of aforesaid glitches.
- v. Members may note that the facility of participation at the EGM through VC/ OAVM will be made available for 1,000 members on a first-come-first-served basis. Regulation 24(5) of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 as amended, ("Listing Regulations"), provides that no company shall dispose of shares in its material subsidiary resulting in reduction of its shareholding (either on its own or together with other subsidiaries) to less than or equal to 50% (fifty percent) or cease the exercise of control over subsidiary without passing a special resolution in general meeting of the company.

Inox Wind Limited (IWL) is a material subsidiary of the Company as per the Listing Regulations. Presently, the Company holds 50.20% of the total Equity Share Capital of IWL. The Special Resolution being recommended to the Members for their approval is an enabling resolution permitting the Company to divest part of its ownership held in IWL to the extent that might attract the provisions of Regulation 24(5) of the Listing Regulations, at any time in future, to meet the long-term working capital requirements and for deleveraging the Company's consolidated business operations.

Towards this, the Board of Directors of the Company on 30th September, 2023, subject to requisite regulatory and other consents, had approved and recommended to the Members for their approval as an enabling resolution under Regulation 24(5) of the Listing Regulations.

The Board of Directors of the Company are of the opinion that the decision regarding divestment would be taken in the best interest of the Company and its Members.

None of the Directors, Key Managerial Personnel of the Company and their relatives is, in any way, concerned or interested, financially or otherwise, in the resolution as set out at Item No. 1 of the Notice.

The Board of Directors of your Company recommends the Resolution as stated at Item No. 1 of the Notice for approval of the Members by way of a Special Resolution.
